# **Some Complementary SES Resume Writing Tips**

Don't give too little. If the info is relevant, no matter how beginine it may seem to you, put it in your SES resume. That detail might help you stand out and get an interview.

Do not give too much. If it is not fully related to the position you seek, leave it out. At the SES resume level, recruiters want a extremely brief, direct reply to their question.
